# Where to park

Bring this map with you as 4 garages will charge \$5 for parking. The yellow on map shows where to find free parking.

- The University of Arizona will charge \$5 to park in four garages that were free of charge to festival goers in previous years. Those are the Main Gate, Tyndall Avenue, Sixth Street and Cherry Avenue garages.
- Two garages, both north of Speedway, remain free for festival goers: Park Avenue and Highland garages.
- All six of these garages are free to festival goers after 4 p.m. each day of the festival.
- The Second Street garage is reserved for authors as in previous years and is not available to the public.
- All of the surface lots in yellow on the map provide free parking. The map also shows the places where shuttle service is available.
- Drivers wanting to park in the pay garages should have their money in hand so they can pay as they enter the garage.
- Lines may form at those pay garages so festival goers should allow at least an extra 30 minutes or more for parking so as not to miss out on presentations.
