The festival is offered free of charge to the public. Parking at the UA is complimentary in many surface lots. The Second Street Garage is for authorized festival personnel only. Public parking is available in all other university garages and certain surface lots for event parking charges of \$10 per day. Parking at the UA is credit card only and cash will not be accepted.

How to navigate the free Tucson Festival of Books

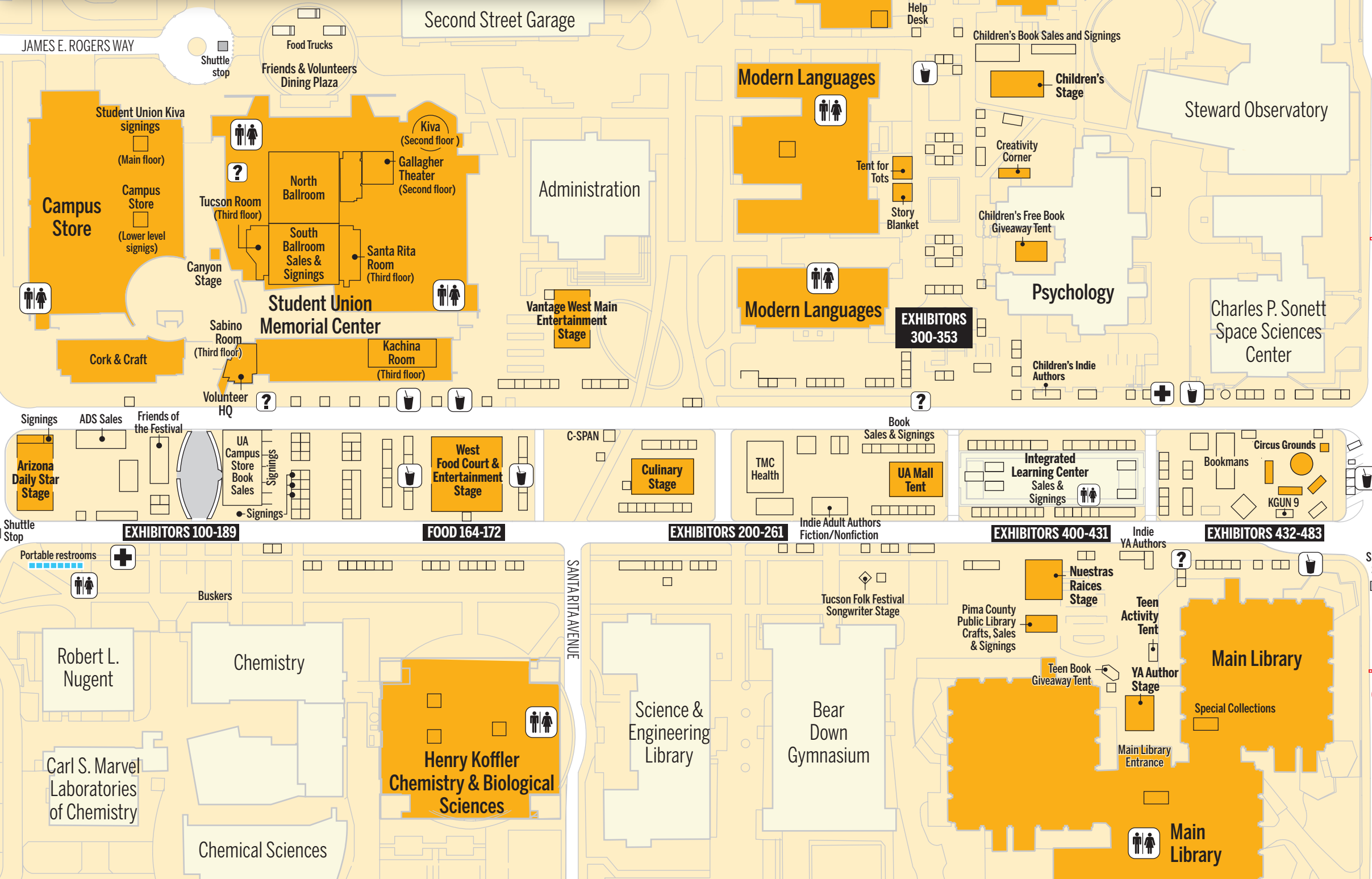
Admission

Every venue will have General Admission available on the day of the event. General Admission is first-come, first-seated. General Admission occurs after sponsors, authors and passholders are seated. We recommend arriving early for presentations by popular authors and in the larger venues that accept passes for the best chance of General Admission. None of our venues will "sell out" before the event date. For all admission types, please enter with your party, as saving seats within the venues is not allowed.

Fast Passes are available on tucsonfestivalofbooks.org, two per day per email address, March 10-14 at noon for a portion of seats in these venues, while supply lasts: North Ballroom, Gallagher Theater, ILC 120, Koeffler 204. Passholders in line at least 20 min before the presentation begins will be allowed to enter before General Admission. As it is possible we will not be able to seat everyone interested in General Admission, Fast Passes obtained in advance can help you plan the best day for yourself. Passes are available free of charge and cannot be sold.
