

Moving west for copper

As part of a proposed reclamation plan, Hudbay Minerals Inc. has told the state it plans to build three open pits, facilities for waste rock and tailings disposal, and buildings for crushers, grinders and flotation equipment on its land on the Santa Rita Mountains' west slope. A power line and a water line are also proposed. The company would put what it calls its Copper World project just northwest of where it still hopes to build the proposed Rosemont Mine.
