Dear Mr. McEnroe

I am writing this letter as the King of the Hashemite Kingdom of Jordan, a father and a friend of the United States.

The loss of your son, Staff Sergeant Kevin McEnroe, must be incredibly hard to bear, but I am sure that you will be immensely proud of how he was conducting himself, getting on with the job in hand and helping out others; he lost his life in the dedicated service of his country. In this he was providing much needed help to Jordan, a close ally of the U.S. and situated in a region of serious turmoil. It is our conclusion, having viewed all the reports, that your son did nothing to instigate this attack and had complied with established procedures at the base. These considerations make the incident at al Jafr Air Base on November 4th all the more disturbing.

We, as a nation, are fully committed to concluding the thorough investigation of this tragedy, which we had done in coordination with agencies of the United States. I can assure you that justice will take its full course and the perpetrator of the attack will be held fully accountable.

The Hashemite Kingdom of Jordan has a proud history of providing sanctuary to friends, travelers and refugees. This makes it the more painful that such a tragic incident should occur.

Please accept my heartfelt condolences, and those of my people. May the Almighty sustain you and your family at this difficult time.
