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HITLER TRIUMPH BRINGS RUMORS OF NEW MOVES

What Next? Is Question In Minds of Many In Europe
BERLIN CELEBRATING New Government Planned For Bohemia Under Nazi Regime

BERLIN, March 15.—(AP)—Adolf Hitler brought the proud lands of the Bohemians and Moravians into his new "German empire" today and quickly set up a new government for the Czechs under the iron hand of German army officials. The Fuehrer himself lost no time in following the victorious troops into dismembered Czechoslovakia and hastened to the ancient Hradec castle where the little republic was dissolved and lived for 39 years. This was extended to a banquet the steadily growing German army. The Fuehrer entered Prague at 11 p. m. (1 p. m. EST). Half an hour later the Nazi aviators appeared on top of the Hradec, waving in a saucy manner that indicated the city.

Arrival Sudden
Hitler's arrival was sudden. He has not been expected until Friday, and the populace was quiet. Earlier his grey-clad, spidery and slender, moving with mechanical precision, had taken firm control of the city and the country. Machine-guns commanded the streets.

At the same time Hitler's forces were said to have entered the "independent" state of Slovakia. While developments indicated the sweep of German power deep in southeastern Europe toward Rumania and Soviet Russia and finally Poland on the eastern coast of the northwest sea.

Washed
Franz Gaus made reports of widespread rumors. A remarkable moment was at hand for the liberation of Munich—German-occupied city of Lithuania which came under domination of Menckel in the last election a few weeks ago.

However, there was no definite indication that a Nazi coup alone in the Hitler sphere was sufficient to bring a crisis in the Polish situation. The Polish said criticism by Britain's premier Chamberlain in London was not due to the fact.

Victorious News
There were said to be no German troops but the former Prague government which had "renewed the spirit of Munich by its actions against the Slovaks."

Further to the east the destruction of the one-remaining republic proceeded. Hungarian troops, received in substance by the Carpatho-Ukraine, eastward of the three divisions of Czechoslovakia which apparently is to be incorporated into Hungary with Hitler's consent, reached the Polish border.

The lightning-like absorption of the country proceeded without protest from other European powers. But chancelleries throughout the European continent closely followed the renouncing of central Europe's map.

Warsaw Analysis
In Warsaw, especially, the historical changes through apprehension of a long common frontier between Poland and the German Reich. The changes gave Poland the appearance on the map of being partly swallowed by Germany.

Democratized Hitler
Former Britain nor France, however, which more than deepened over developments. Both the western democracies were reacting during the swift moving events which accomplished the end of the Czech-Slovak republic.

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PRAGUE WEEPS AS GERMANY'S TROOPS APPEAR

Army Men Are Boomed as Hitler Moves in Without Bands
GESTAPO IS ACTIVE Iron Hand Prepared for Those Who Defy Orders

PRAGUE, March 15.—(AP)—Adolf Hitler took possession of Bohemia and Moravia today, personally following his grey-clad Nazi troops into Prague itself with a suddenness that completely surprised an already bewildered Czech population. Tonight he symbolized his lightning conquest by sleeping in the old castle under Gothic vaults of makers of Bohemian brass. There are no bands, no plaudits, no "Czechoslovak republic restored."

Without the customary fanfare, a few hundred soldiers entered the city quietly at 1 p. m. (4 p. m. EST). The soldiers, however, bore columns of his troops who were dressed and armed by Hitler. Czechs—thirty 20 years of independence now and the Sudetenland.

Government Set Up
As the Fuehrer entered, Prague the Prussian military already had set up a temporary military and civil government to rule Bohemia and Moravia as protectorates of the greater German reich, in which Hitler would fit in with accepted German racial theories.

On the other hand, the Czechs who had come to the city, in which they were to be accepted the same bans and regulations which were being imposed on the Sudetenland.

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ARTILLERY USED TO FIGHT THEM DURING ADVANCE

Field Campaign May Be Arranged to Crush Czech Troops
BORDER IS REACHED Poles Hail Groups Which Win Way Through Snow Storm

BUDAPEST, March 15.—(AP)—Hungarian troops marching northward to occupy Carpatho-Ukraine of the fallen Czech-Slovak republic were being resisted tonight by artillery and machine gun fire, a foreign official spokesman announced. The spokesman admitted that there had been Hungarian casualties, but that no serious fighting was being waged. He said that the fighting was going on despite the fact that the Hungarian ultimatum to withdraw Czech troops from the region was apparently being respected.
