

LT. PETER WAID KILLED IN CRASH

Lt. Peter Hamlin Waid was killed January 25 in an airplane crash in Lubbock, Tex., relatives announced here yesterday. A graduate of Tucson High School and a former student at the University of Arizona, he had been in the army since January 1942. He was commissioned in September, 1943.

He was the son of Mr. and Mrs. Jesse A. Waid of Scarsdale, N. Y. His wife, the former Miss Prudence Myrland, is the daughter of Mr. and Mrs. Otto Myrland of Tucson.

A midair collision resulted in Lieutenant Waid's death.

Before leaving Tucson he worked for the Valley National Bank.

Burial will be Wednesday in Arlington Cemetery in Washington, D. C.
