

A rising tide of PFAS contamination

PFAS concentrations have been found as high as 10,000 parts per trillion in groundwater well samples taken northwest of the Air National Guard Base at Tucson International Airport. Various wells were sampled between March 2018 and March 2021. The PFAS in groundwater is believed to be heading toward the Tucson Airport Remediation Project plant, or TARP, which removes PFAS from the water along with other contaminants.
