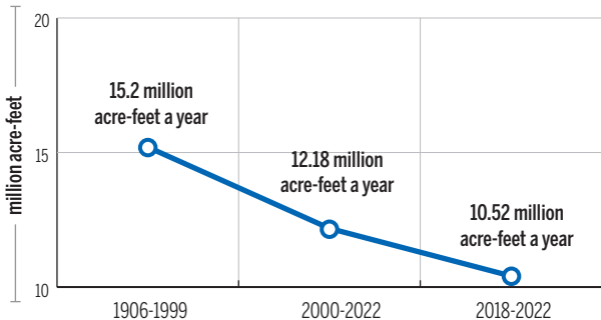


Shrinking Colorado River flows

Average annual flows on the river have declined steadily since 2000. Human-caused climate change has been linked to up to half that decline by at least two studies.
