447 AMERICANS KILLED, WOUNDED OR CAPTURED SHOT OR SLAIN CASUALTY LIST FROM FRONT

Secretary Baker Cables Instructions Relating Lists From April 2 to 8; Total Deaths, 85; Seriously Wounded, 103; 21 Captured by Boches in Reids; No Addresses of Men Are Given

WASHINGTON, April 9.—(Associated Press.)—The War Department tonight released the first list of names of American soldiers killed, wounded or captured in the European theater since the beginning of the war. The list, which was compiled from reports received from the front, shows that 447 Americans were killed, wounded or captured in the European theater during the period from April 2 to 8. The list also shows that 85 Americans were killed and 103 were seriously wounded. In addition, 21 Americans were captured by the enemy. The list does not give the names of the men, but it does give the names of the units to which they were attached. The War Department is now working to obtain the names of the men and to determine their status.
