

GUARDS WATCH AIR BASE HERE

Roads Are Watched With Armed Men Placed On Duty

Guards, with bayoneted rifles, were placed around Dover-Mitchell Field, the local U.S. army airbase, yesterday as well as road sections through that institution and between the base and the United States.

The men who had no official work were sitting at the entrance to the American Airlines terminal, and prevented anyone of the public from leaving the huge landing field. Guards also were in evidence at the Department of Commerce's new transportation office in the American Airlines terminal building.

Officials of the Texas A&M (Tex) stated last night that all necessary steps would be taken to prevent sabotage in all industrial plants in the district.
