
**U.S. District Judge Susan Bolton ¶**

¶ Bolton was referring to the law's "reasonable suspicion" ← mandate.




**Sen. Russell Pearce ¶**

¶ Goddard, Arizona's attorney general, is running for governor.




**U.S. Rep. Raúl Grijalva ¶**
