**Bibby, Simon: NBA draft is not in their plans**

**But they say they feel the lure of pro basketball**

**INDIANAPOLIS** - Rest easy, Mike Bibby is not going anywhere, even after next year. The NBA is not in his thoughts.

No, really, it's true.

"I honestly think, and this is my personal opinion, that Mike Bibby will graduate from the University of Arizona before he turns pro," said UA assistant coach Jesse Evans, who shares a strong relationship with Bibby, and the freshman's mother, Virginia.

"I think his family wants him to do that. It means a lot to them."

Whether that really happens will be interesting to see. Virginia Bibby has said before that she does not like the glitz and glamour of the NBA lifestyle, having seen her estranged husband, Henry Bibby, go through that.

But the money will be tempting. Ron Mercer, a Kentucky sophomore who is a certain lottery pick, jumped at the chance to move on.

"I don't know what Bibby's situation is, so I couldn't really give him advice," Mercer said. "It comes down to the individual and his family's needs. I just think we have different situations."

Bibby, who is likely to garner All-American honors next year, wears a tattoo of the NBA logo on his left hand. "I got the size with Paul Westphal in it," Bibby said. When told it was actually Jerry West, he said, "Oh, whatever."

Although he is cool under pressure, he still has that youthful innocence. He realizes he still has more growing up to do.

"It's nice that people think that highly of me, going into the NBA, even after this year," he said, "but that's not on my mind. I have a lot of work to do. I don't think about it a whole lot."

Miles Simon, rated the 2006-best prospect by NBA draft guru Don Leventhal, said he would look forward more to returning next year and playing with the rest of his team. The UA is likely to be a preseason No. 1 team with everybody back.

"That excites me more than anything," he said.

**Terry ready for finale after fluid-boosting IV**

**INDIANAPOLIS** - Late Olson, realizing that Jason Terry is the comical character on the team, managed to laugh at the guard's expense yesterday.

The night before, shortly after Arizona beat North Carolina in the Final Four, Terry was in the hospital receiving fluids intravenously to cure dehydration.

"He did leave a deposit in the ambulance on the way to the hospital," Olson said. "So he was a sick puppy last night."

Terry appeared to be in good spirits yesterday before Arizona practiced. He managed to laugh about his sickness.

"I guess I got a little too excited about the game," Terry said. "I was coming down with the cold, and I guess I didn't drink enough water or whatever during the day."

"I'm OK now, though. I feel a lot better. I'm ready to go."

Terry, who played only 20 minutes against the Tar Heels and looked out of sync with his passes, could not believe that instead of celebrating the victory he was vomiting in an ambulance.

"At least I got some of that stuff out of my system," he said. "Going to the hospital was no big thing, really, because I wasn't there that long."

Terry seemed to be a little groggy, but he said playing in the national championship today against Kentucky can cure that.

Or on the other hand, it can make him even more excited and get the butterflies going a little stronger in his stomach.

He'll try his hardest to avoid that.

"I'm going to drink water all day (today)," he said, smiling. "I'm going to drink a lot all day during the night before I go to sleep, too."

bench for 12 games earlier this year because of academic problems.

In those 12 games when Simon was ineligible, Dickerson averaged 23.6 points and Arizona was 10-2.

"He just knew he had to pick up his game tremendously," Simon said. "And him being the one that was locked on at the start, he just came out and put up big-time numbers from the start. He took it upon himself to carry the team and lead the way at the start."

**DICKERSON'S WOES**

Dickerson's teammates can only hope so.

"I feel for Michael," Simon said. "He wants to do so well for this team. When he's struggling like this, it's hard to watch. You want him to snap out of it."
