Paper and cardboard

- Newspapers
- Magazines
- Cardboard cereal or pasta box
- Milk cartons
- Shredded paper in a clear plastic bag Inside Tucson and with Arizona Sanitation and Hughes; in a box for RAD
- Junk mail and office paper
- Phone books
- Cardboard packing boxes; if there's a lot of packing tape, remove it, just a little is fine

- Take-out coffee cups or soda cups, plastic lids
- Political signs
- Gift wrap
- Photos
- Tracing or tissue paper
- Dog food bags with the plastic liner
- Foil-lined boxes
- Books
- Shredded paper outside Tucson city limits except for AZ Sanitation, Hughes and RAD

Metals

- Aluminum foil and disposable roasting pans and pie tins, clean and dry
- Vegetable or soup cans and soda cans,
- Pressurized cans like aerosol unless it contained something toxic

- Alkaline batteries
- Shell casings picked up off the shooting range
- Cardboard cans with metal rim
- Microwave or other old appliances

Glass

- Glass jars and bottles (throw lids away)
- Wine bottles

- Broken glass
- Heat-resistant glass
- Crystal

Plastics

- Empty plastic condiment bottles
- Lunch meat plastic container, produce and takeout clamshells, etc
- Empty lotion bottles if you can get all of the lotion out
- Plastic drink and water bottles (Keep lids attached)
- Plastic milk jug
- Yogurt and sour cream containers

- Pill bottles
- Plastic drinking straws
- Plastic grocery bags
- Plastic foam and Styrofoam
- Plastic foam fast-food cups or coffee cups
- Bubble wrap
- Plastic pool cover and pool cleaner hoses
- K-cups

Other

Don't recycle these curbside:

- Hazardous waste
- CDs
- Wine corks
- Rubber bands
- PCV or ABS pipe
- Batteries
