

2026 ALL-MOUNTAIN LAKES SOFTBALL TEAM



ABI BLACKWELL, WEST-OAK, P, SR.
A North-South All-Star and a member of the Western 3A all-region team, Blackwell batted .389 with six home runs and 32 RBI. Playing at third base and pitching, she had a perfect fielding percentage and also went 3-1 in the circle with 23 strikeouts and a 1.58 ERA.

ANNA BLACKWELL, WEST-OAK, IF, SR.

Playing first base and pitching for the Warriors, Blackwell earned a trip to the North-South All-Star Game and made the Western 3A all-region team after batting .410 with four home runs and 34 RBI. She also went 3-0 pitching with 22 strikeouts and a 1.03 ERA.



MARA CHAPPELL, WALHALLA, IF, SR.
A Western 3A all-region honoree, Chappell — who played shortstop and third base — batted .421 for the Razorbacks and had six RBI. She also batted .462 with runners in scoring position.

EMILY GOOCH, DANIEL, IF, 8TH

A member of the Region II-4A all-region team, the Lions' second baseman batted .402 with seven doubles, a triple, two home runs, 23 RBI and 17 runs scored.



KYNDALL LEEPER, SENECA, OF, FR.
Leeper batted .396 during her freshman season with 19 RBI and 12 stolen bases. She also had a .438 on-base percentage.

LUCY MAXON, DANIEL, OF, SR.

Maxon batted .456 with nine doubles, three triples, four home runs, 25 RBI and 22 runs scored on the way to earning a spot on the Region II-4A all-region team.



KYLIE PERKINS, WEST-OAK C, SO.
An all-state performer and a member of the Western 3A all-region team, Perkins hit .489 for the Warriors with seven home runs, 38 RBI and a perfect fielding percentage behind the plate.

EMILY PIPES, SENECA, U, SR.

Pipes was a North-South All-Star and a member of the Region II-4A all-region team after she batted .352 with 23 RBI. The Bobcats' standout catcher also had a perfect fielding percentage.

Stoltzfus had a year to remember in helping lead the Warriors to their first region championship in 42 years. She was named the Western 3A Player of the Year and earned all-state honors after going 16-4 in the circle with 146 strikeouts and a 2.60 ERA. At the plate, she batted .407 with 10 home runs and 40 RBI.



TORY ROY, WEST-OAK, U, SO.

Roy batted .424 with a home run, 17 RBI and 23 runs scored on the way to earning a spot on the Western 3A all-region team.

BRYLEE WHITFIELD, WEST-OAK, IF, JR.

The Warriors' shortstop earned Western 3A all-region honors after batting .383 with a home run, 30 RBI and 28 runs scored.



TEAGAN WHITFIELD, WEST-OAK, OF, 8TH

Whitfield batted an impressive .430 for the Warriors this spring with a home run, 16 RBI and 37 runs scored. She also stole 18 bases.

SOPHIA WYLIE, SENECA, P, SO.

An all-state honoree and a member of the Region II-4A all-region team, Wylie went 20-7 in the circle with 142 strikeouts. At the plate, she batted .442 with two home runs and 24 RBI, while she was also a perfect 35-of-35 on her stolen-base attempts.
