

2026 ALL-MOUNTAIN LAKES BASEBALL TEAM



Player of the Year
WILLIAM CUTSHALL,
SENECA, P/SS, SR.

Closing his Seneca career strong, Cutshall was named the Class 4A Co-Player of the Year and the Region II-4A Player of the Year, while he also was invited to take part in the North-South All-Star Game. He batted an eye-popping .543 with nine doubles, a triple, nine home runs and 37 RBI, while he also stole 16 bases. On the mound, he went 5-1 and had a save, finishing with a 1.98 ERA and 50 strikeouts in 33 innings of work.

LIAM PURCELL, DANIEL, U, SR.

Purcell earned Region II-4A all-region honors after batting .429 with 11 doubles, four home runs, 38 RBI and 25 runs scored. He also went 5-2 on the mound with a 3.04 ERA with 29 strikeouts in 23 innings pitched.



CAL SCHNABEL, DANIEL, 2B, SO.

After hitting .411 with nine doubles, a home run, 24 RBI and 25 runs scored, Schnabel secured a spot on the Region II-4A all-region team.



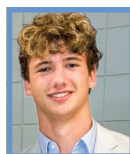
TY SIMPSON, DANIEL, 3B, SR.

The Lions' all-time leader in home runs, Simpson ended his senior year by earning Region II-4A all-region honors after batting .433 with 11 doubles, a triple, seven home runs, 35 RBI and 23 runs scored. He also stole 21 bases.



CORBIN SPILLIARDS, DANIEL, SS, JR.

A Region II-4A all-region honoree, Spilliards batted .435 with 12 doubles, four triples, two home runs, 18 RBI and 34 runs. He also stole 16 bases while going 4-2 on the mound with a save and a 3.00 ERA in 32.2 innings of work.



TYLER VASSEY, SENECA, P, SR.

The Region II-4A Pitcher of the Year, a North-South All-Star and an all-state selection, Vassey went 9-2 with two saves and had a 1.64 ERA. He finished with 101 strikeouts against only 12 walks, while opposing batters hit just .142 against him. He also batted .304 with seven home runs and 34 RBI.



JAKE WILLIAMS, WEST-OAK, U, SO.

Williams batted .316 with three doubles, a triple, two home runs, 13 RBI and 19 runs, while he also stole 14 bases. A Western 3A all-region honoree, Williams also had a 2.74 ERA with 60 strikeouts against 14 walks in 51 innings on the mound.

DALTON DIAL, WALHALLA, P, SR.

The Western 3A Player of the Year, a North-South All-Star and an all-state selection, Dial went 8-2 with two saves on the mound with a 1.92 ERA, a .193 opponents' batting average and 91 strikeouts against just 17 walks. At the plate, he hit .382 with 10 doubles, three triples and 19 RBI.

WESTON HARDIN, WALHALLA, OF, SO.

Hardin batted .302 with seven doubles, two home runs, 22 RBI and 14 runs scored on the way to earning Western 3A all-region honors.

TOBIE LOWE, DANIEL, C, JR.

In his first season with the Lions, Lowe earned a spot on the Region II-4A all-region team after batting .467 with six doubles, a home run and 27 RBI.

ELI PAYNE, DANIEL, OF, SR.

The senior batted .391 on the season with seven doubles, 12 RBI and 23 runs scored for the Lions.

COLLIN PHILLIPS, WALHALLA, 1B, JR.

An all-state selection and a member of the Western 3A all-region team, Phillips batted .333 with nine doubles, eight home runs, 24 RBI and 24 runs scored. On the mound, he went 5-2 with a 2.28 ERA, a .205 opponents' batting average and 74 strikeouts against 17 walks. He also tossed a no-hitter.

WILL PHILPOTT, SENECA, OF, JR.

Philpott was named to the Region II-4A all-region team after he batted .338 with four doubles, a triple, 10 RBI and 30 runs scored. He also had 14 stolen bases.
