WALKER BUCK, WEST-OAK, OF, SR.

Buck earned a spot on the Western 3A all-region team after batting .348 with four doubles, seven RBI, 13 stolen bases and a .465 on-base percentage.



SPENCER CONN, DANIEL, C, SR.

Conn concluded a decorated career with the Lions by earning Region II-4A all-region honors after he batted .426 with 13 doubles, four home runs and 29 RBI.



QUINT CUMBIE, DANIEL, U, SR.

After batting an-area best .533, Cumbie was named to the Region II-4A all-region team. Playing in the outfield, first base and third base, Cumbie also had six doubles, 17 RBI, 40 runs scored and 20 stolen bases.



DALTON DIAL, WALHALLA, P, JR.

Dial turned in a stellar year on the mound for the Razorbacks, as he went 4-4 with a 2.00 ERA on the way to earning Western 3A all-region honors. He also had a region-best 77 strikeouts against only 18 walks in 59.1 innings of work.



IAN MCCRARY, DANIEL, P, SR.

McCrary was dominant for the Lions, as he went 9-2 with a 1.68 ERA, a .181 opponents' batting average and 103 strikeouts against just 22 walks in 62.1 innings. For his efforts, McCrary earned all-state honors, an invitation to the North-South All-Star Game and a spot on the Region II-4A all-region team.



JOEY MCGOVERN, SENECA, OF, SR.

A North-South All-Star and a member of the Region II-4A all-region team, McGovern batted .390, had a .500 on-base percentage and totaled 10 doubles, six home runs, 31 RBI and 32 runs scored.



JASEAN PERRY, DANIEL, OF, SR.

Perry earned all-state honors and a North-South All-Star Game invitation after batting .353 with six doubles, 18 RBI and 10 stolen bases. On the mound, he went 1-2 with a 4.00 ERA and a .237 opponents' batting average in 21 innings.



Player of the Year WILLIAM CUTSHALL, SENECA, P/SS, JR.

Cutshall enjoyed a monumental season in helping the Bobcats to the Class 4A Upper State championship in his junior season. The Class 4A Player of the Year and Region II-4A Player of the Year went 12-1 on the mound with a 1.50 ERA and 121 strikeouts in 72.2 innings of work. At the plate, he batted .518, had an on-base percentage of .595 and had 13 doubles, three triples, nine home runs, 40 RBI and 47 runs scored.



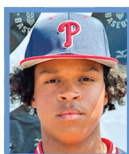
COLLIN PHILLIPS, WALHALLA, IF, SO.

Phillips was a Western 3A all-region selection after batting .380 with 35 hits — the second-highest total in the region — including a region-best four home runs. He also had eight doubles and 35 RBI.

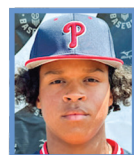
COLLIN PHILLIPS, WALHALLA, IF, SO.
