

Pocket Fire

83% contained

Today there has been no change to the fire perimeter as all containment lines continue to hold with very little heat evident. Most resources are now committed to suppression repair work.

The last remaining heat detected exists in the bottom of West Fork of Oak Creek Canyon, east of Barney Spring Canyon, where terrain is inaccessible to firefighters. This heat is well contained by previous retardant drops and has also received significant wetting rain over the past two days.

Highway 89A is open in both directions.

The last of the chipping work is expected to be completed over the next several days, although storms continue to cause delays across the fire area as resources retreat to the safety of higher ground.

The only chipping left to do in the southern portion of the fire is in the Enchantment area. This work is expected to be completed over the next several days, although storms continue to cause delays across the fire area as resources retreat to the safety of higher ground.
