HYDE PARK FIRE DISTRICT #1

The legal voters of the Hyde Park Fire District No. 1 are hereby notified and warned to meet at North Hyde Park Fire Station in North Hyde Park, on **Tuesday, August 11, 2026**, between the hours of seven o'clock (7:00) in the forenoon (a.m.), at which time the polls will open, and seven o'clock (7:00) in the afternoon (p.m.), at which time the polls will close, to vote by Australian ballot upon the following Article of business:

ARTICLE 1

Shall general obligation bonds of the Hyde Park Fire District No. 1 in an amount not to exceed Six Hundred Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$650,000), subject to reduction from the receipt of available state and federal grants-in-aid, be issued for the purpose of making improvements to the existing pump station facilities and reservoir site for the District's water system, including removing and replacing a hydropneumatic tank, interior piping, installing a standby generator and booster tanks?

The legal voters of the Hyde Park Fire District No. 1 are further notified that voter qualification, registration and absentee voting relative to said meeting shall be as provided in Chapters 43, 51 and 55 of Title 17 and Section 2484 of Title 20, Vermont Statutes Annotated.

The legal voters of the Hyde Park Fire District No. 1 are further notified that an informational meeting will be held on **Thursday, August 6, 2026**, at the North Hyde Park Fire Station in the Village of Hyde Park at six o'clock (6:00) in the evening (p.m.), for the purpose of explaining the proposed improvements and the financing thereof.
