**Special City Meeting
August 11, 2026**

The legal voters of the City of South Burlington, are hereby notified and warned to meet at their respective polling places at the Chamberlin School on White Street, the Frederick H. Tuttle Middle School on Dorset Street, the Orchard School on Baldwin Avenue, and the Kevin Dorn Senior Center in City Hall on Market Street on Tuesday, August 11, 2026, between the hours of seven o'clock (7:00) in the forenoon (a.m.), at which time the polls will open, and seven o'clock (7:00) in the afternoon (p.m.), at which time the polls will close, to vote by Australian ballot upon the following Article:

ARTICLE I

Shall the City of South Burlington make capital improvements to the Bartlett Bay Wastewater Treatment Facility, install a clarifier at the Airport Parkway wastewater treatment facility and refurbish or replace four wastewater pump stations and issue general obligation bonds or notes in an amount not to exceed Sixteen Million Four Hundred Thousand and 00/100 Dollars (\$16,400,000.00), together with other general obligation bonds or notes in the amount of Thirty-Three Million Eight Hundred Thirty-Three Thousand and 00/100 (\$33,833,000.00) previously approved on March 7, 2023, after application of other funds and resources available for these purposes, to finance these capital improvements and to pay expenses related to the issuance of the bonds, the total cost of which is not to exceed Fifty Million Two Hundred Thirty-Three Thousand and 00/100 Dollars (\$50,233,000.00)?

The legal voters of the City of South Burlington are further notified that voter qualification, registration and absentee voting relative to said special meeting shall be as provided in Chapters 43, 51 and 55 of Title 17, Vermont Statutes Annotated.

The legal voters of the City of South Burlington are further notified that a public informational hearing will be held on Monday, August 10, 2026, at South Burlington City Hall, 180 Market Street in the City of South Burlington and electronically on the Zoom platform at the following link beginning at six o'clock (6:00) in the evening (p.m.), for the purpose of explaining the proposed projects and the financing thereof.
