

ACT 250 NOTICE
MINOR APPLICATION 5L0179-C
10 V.S.A. §§ 6000 - 6111

On March 10, 2026, Application 5L0179-C was filed by the Town of Johnson, P.O. Box 383, Johnson VT 05656 and deemed complete on June 3, 2026. The project is generally described as the addition of a new concrete flat bottom "bowl" to be constructed in the existing skatepark. The bowl will have sloped grass berms and a short path on the southeast end to connect with an existing asphalt skating area. The project is located at 178 Wescom Road in Johnson, Vermont. The application may be viewed on the Land Use Review Board's website (<https://act250.vermont.gov/>) Click on "Act 250 Database" and enter project number 5L0179-C.

No hearing will be held, and a permit may be issued unless, on or before July 6, 2026, a party notifies the District 5 Commission in writing of an issue requiring a hearing, or the Commission sets the matter for a hearing on its own motion. Any person as defined in 10 V.S.A. § 6085(c)(1) may request a hearing. Any hearing request must be in writing, must state the criteria or sub-criteria at issue, why a hearing is required, and what additional evidence will be presented at the hearing. Any hearing request by an adjoining property owner or other person eligible for party status under 10 V.S.A. § 6085(c)(1)(E) must include a petition for party status under the Act 250 Rules. Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law will not be prepared unless the Commission holds a public hearing. For ore information contact the Coordinator listed below.
