Administrative Use of Force Review

On February 1, 2022, a review of a Use of Force incident was conducted by Sgt. Bruce Beuerlein as directed by standing policy. The incident occurred on January 23, 2022, and a Response to Resistance (Use of Force) Form was submitted by Corporal Marcoux.

The review was conducted pursuant to a standard Use of Force review protocol and not in response to any specific allegation by the person subjected to the response or anyone else. As of the date of this report no allegations have been made against this department or any of the officers involved.

The Use of Force incident occurred on January 23, 2022, at approximately 1530 hours and involved [REDACTED]. The Use of Force occurred [REDACTED] in the Town of Shelburne. [REDACTED] The Use of Force as described by Cpl Marcoux occurred as [REDACTED] was being taken into custody on a charge of Operating a Vehicle without Owner's Consent.

- Axon Body Camera recording of Ofc. Robert Lake dated January 23, 2022 (Total of one)
- Axon Cruiser 368 (rear mounted) Camera recording of January 23, 2022 (Total of one)
- Axon Cruiser 368 (dash mounted) Camera recording of January 23, 2022 (Total of one)

In reviewing the dispatch information in Valcour, at approximately 1447 hours, Shelburne Emergency Communications Technician (ECT) Laurie Fox received a telephone call from [REDACTED]

[REDACTED] was looking for assistance from an officer.

Cpl Marcoux left [REDACTED] [REDACTED] and traveled northward, [REDACTED] [REDACTED] [REDACTED] onto Shelburne Rd. Cpl Marcoux observed [REDACTED] vehicle heading south shortly after he had started north on Shelburne Rd. He turned his cruiser and drove south. Cpl Marcoux stated in his narrative the vehicle was traveling northward. [REDACTED] had stopped in the left-hand turn lane at Shelburne Rd [REDACTED] [REDACTED]. Cpl Marcoux stopped in the travel lane just behind [REDACTED]. When the traffic control light signaled for left hand turns [REDACTED] and the vehicle directly behind [REDACTED] did so. Cpl Marcoux followed the two vehicles [REDACTED] [REDACTED] [REDACTED]. Cpl Marcoux activated his cruiser's emergency lights and chirped its siren. The second vehicle pulled over and Cpl Marcoux continued after [REDACTED]. He activated the cruiser's siren again for several seconds. [REDACTED] pulled to the side of the road and partially in the rear parking lot of [REDACTED] [REDACTED] at approximately 1530 hours.

Cpl Marcoux returns to [REDACTED] vehicle, turns it off and removes [REDACTED] cell phone. Cpl Marcoux begins to drive to the police station as he does so, he advised dispatch that [REDACTED] is under arrest and requests Officer Lake meet him at the station. No beginning mileage is given.

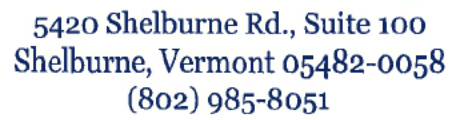
As Cpl Marcoux is backing the cruiser into the sallyport he tells [REDACTED]. [REDACTED]

Cpl Marcoux goes into the station and [REDACTED]. As he is returning to the sallyport Officer Lake arrives and they speak in the hallway. Cpl Marcoux tells Ofc Lake that [REDACTED].

Both officers return to the cruiser and Ofc Lake has [REDACTED] step out of the cruiser. He is leading [REDACTED] toward the processing area with Cpl Marcoux trailing. Ofc Lake is unlocking the sallyport door while [REDACTED] looks over her shoulder at Cpl Marcoux. [REDACTED]

Cpl Marcoux leaves [REDACTED] with Ofc Lake so he can start paperwork.

In the processing area [REDACTED] tells Ofc Lake, [REDACTED]. As Ofc Lake is removing the handcuffs he asks [REDACTED]. [REDACTED]
