
School board work is primarily monitoring and oversight. This is in direct contrast to the active role I played throughout my business career. I enjoy working with others on specific issues, developing solutions, implementing those solutions and monitoring progress. You could say I am a hands-on person rather than one who works at an arms-length away.

An additional reason for this resignation is the lack of respect and civility displayed at recent board meetings. This type of conduct continued at the September 6 meeting with a comment directed at me. This was the first time that I was made aware of the issue despite attending meetings and exchanging emails, throughout the summer, with the individual that made the remark. I will not participate in public criticism of others, nor do I wish to work in this type of environment I try to treat people in a respectful manner and believe my meeting conduct confirms this.

This decision has been given much consideration. I am hopeful that someone will come forward who is a better fit for this work. Someone who can provide the community and all district employees the level of performance they greatly deserve. The most enjoyable part of this experience has been the people I have been fortunate to meet.
