

NEBRASKA OFFERS SCANT AID TO CRIME VICTIMS

Between Oct. 1, 2019, and Sept. 30, 2021, Nebraska's Crime Victim's Reparations program approved fewer applicants and spent less money reimbursing them than programs in almost every other surrounding state. It also took Nebraska longer than most to process applications. Note: States' programs can differ in several meaningful ways, including application processing, funding and eligibility requirements.

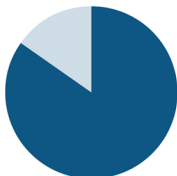
