## City of Marthasville, Missouri INVITATION TO BID 2019 PAVING

The City of Marthasville is hereby soliciting bids for its 2019 spring paving program.

The City of Marthasville is seeking bids for providing 2" asphalt overlays on certain roadways in Marthasville. The City of Marthasville reserves the right to add or delete work at the per ton price, provided the work is of a similar nature, including street patching/repair, and driveway entrances/aprons. All mix specifications shall be in accordance with MoDOT standards and bid per ton.

Contractor is responsible for paving all intersection aprons / flairs. Contractor is responsible to roll down to match all intersecting driveways / entrances onto the roads being paved. Contractor shall provide a minimum 7' wide tapered milled edge at all butt joints, curb and gutting, or concrete edges in order to receive a full 2" thick overlay. Contractor shall maintain a crown in the middle of the roads to promote water drainage. The successful bidder will provide all necessary services in order to prepare the surface for proper paving including all necessary sweeping or cleaning of the pavement prior to paving. The bidder shall provide traffic control at either end of the job at all times to safely direct traffic. The successful bidder will be responsible for placing temporary construction signs indicating paving is taking place on that road. The successful bidder shall provide certificates of insurance for Workers' Compensation and liability insurance, including evidence of coverage for all subcontractors.

The City of Marthasville requests:

1. That the bid specify the cost per ton for asphalt mix, including all costs for paving, rolling and all ancillary services required for application of the pavement materials.
2. An estimate of the number of tons per roadway, with 2" overlay.
3. An estimate of the number of gallons of tack oil per roadway, using a minimum of 1/10 gallon per square yard.
4. An estimate for any repairs at a rate per cubic yard.
5. The total estimated dollar cost per roadway.
6. The City of Marthasville requests that the work be completed no later than April 30, 2019.

The City of Marthasville reserves the right to change mileage or roads involved. It is the intent of the City of Marthasville to cap the maximum amount to be expended, subject to City Board of Aldermen appropriations. The scope of work will be scaled up or down to fit the budget based on the per ton price and budget per street provided by the successful bidder.

Bids are due in the office of the City Clerk no later than **Tuesday, February 19, 2019, at 4:00 P.M.**, at which time there will be a public opening of the bids. The Board of Aldermen will conduct a review of bids at the next regularly scheduled Board of Aldermen meeting, Wednesday, February 20, 2019.

The City of Marthasville reserves the right to accept or reject any and all bids.

The following streets are proposed for work to be done in 2019:

1. **Crestview Drive:** mill along curbing and overlay existing road with milled butt joints.
2. **Ozark Drive:** mill along curbing and overlay existing road with milled butt joints.
3. **Hiawatha Street (North End):** mill along curbing and overlay existing road with milled butt joints, grade and compact gravel as necessary along new curbing.
4. **Boone Terrace Drive:** mill along curbing and overlay existing road.
5. **Stegner Drive:** mill along curbing and overlay existing road.
6. **Debra Drive:** mill along curbing and overlay existing road with milled butt joints.
7. **Tanglewood Drive:** mill along curbing and overlay existing road with milled butt joints.
8. **Northridge Drive (East of Hiawatha):** mill along curbing and overlay existing road with milled butt joints.
9. **Southridge Court:** mill along curbing and overlay existing road.

**All streets are to receive a sufficient tack oil base, then a 2-inch overlay with BP2 grade asphalt mix. The streets are to be done in separate pulls with no more than 2 pulls per street.**

**Note all locations and lengths approximate based on limitations of instruments and mapping scales.**
