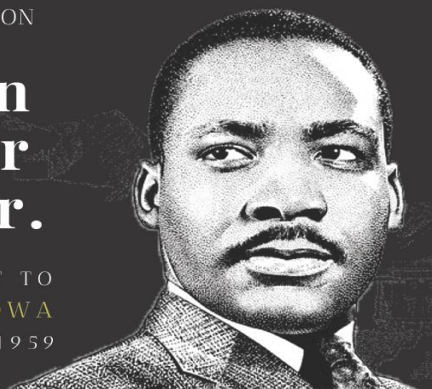
African American History Tent
