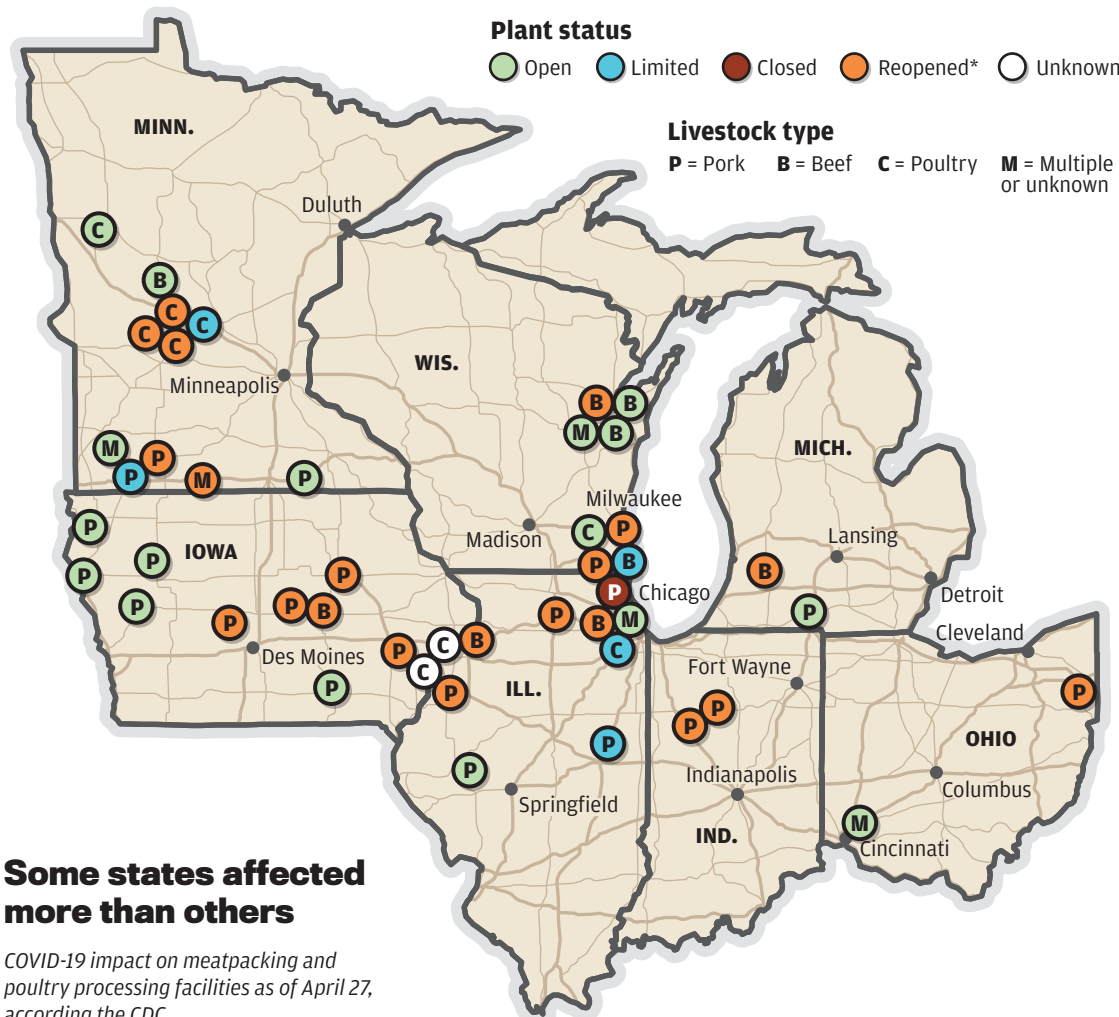


Large Midwestern meatpacking plants

Meatpacking is an economic driver in communities across the Midwest, relying on a network of plants to distribute products around the world. Here's look at some of the large-scale packing plants and poultry processors:
