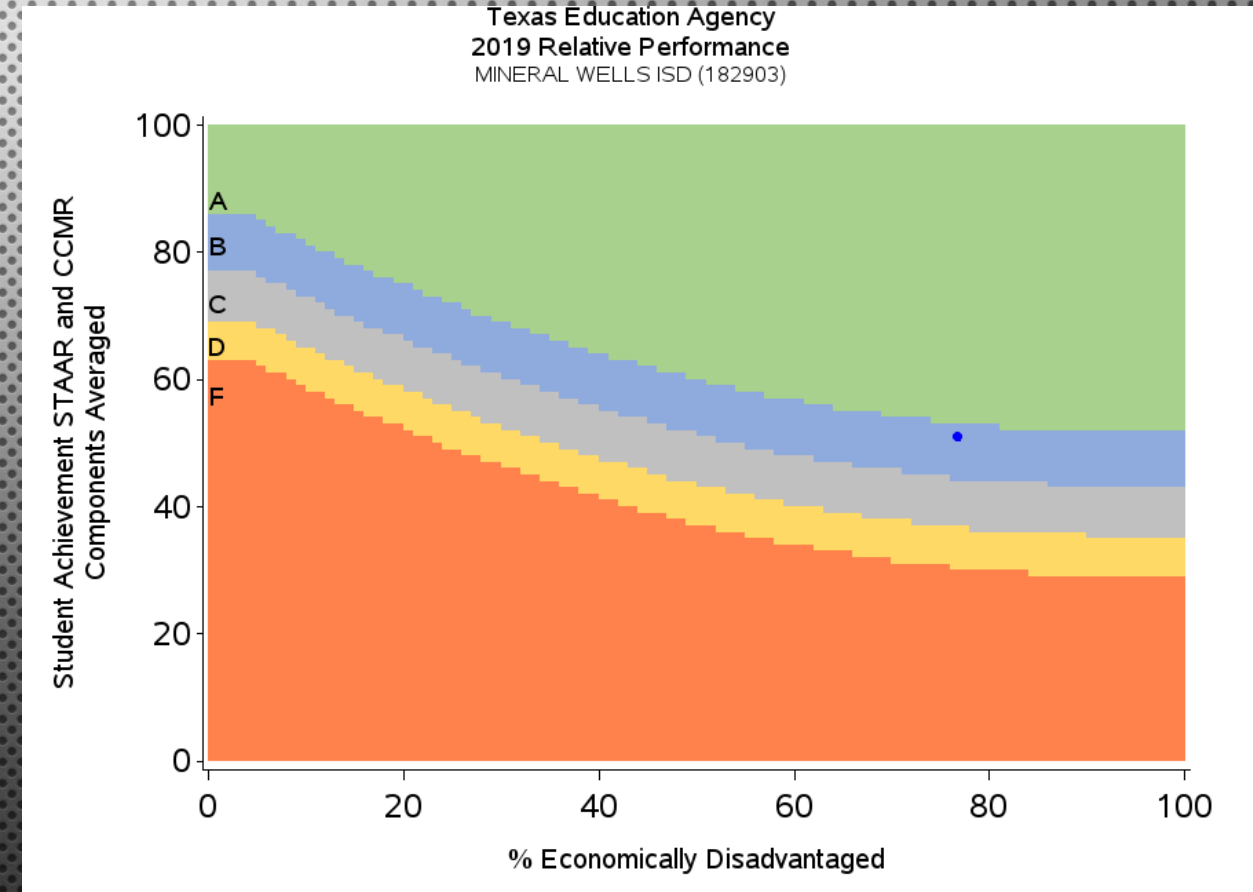
Comparisons with the state

Other Notable Improvements:

- 93% of Students Passed US History EOC
- Best Overall Improvement on STAAR at Approaches - English I and Algebra I
- Best Overall Improvement on STAAR at Meets and Masters - 8th Grade Reading

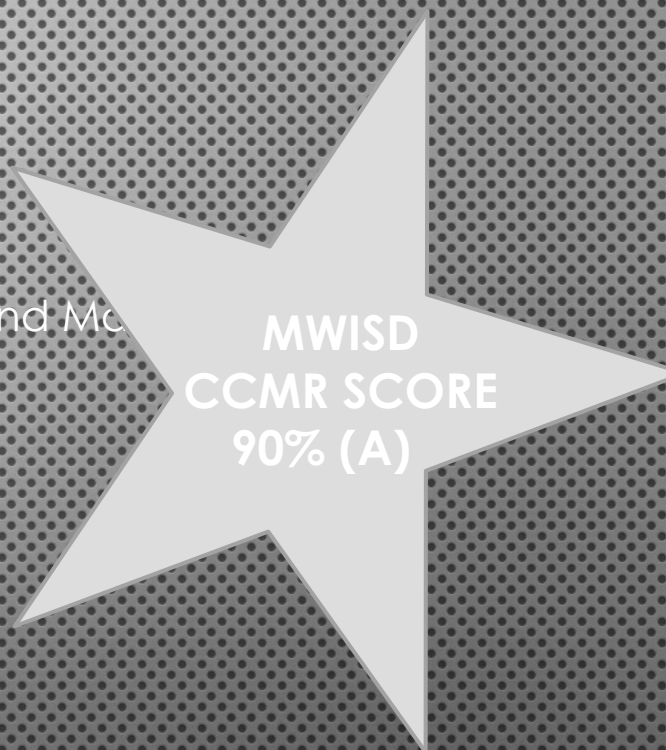

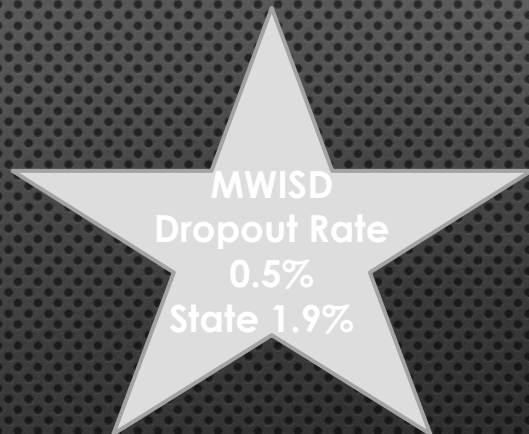
