Dear T.W. Josey High School Families,

In an effort to keep you informed, I am writing to make you aware of several incidents that occurred on our campus this week. Earlier this week, several students were involved in separate altercations during a class transition. Out of an abundance of caution, we temporarily limited class transitions while administrators and Richmond County School System (RCSS) Police responded. RCSS Police determined that the altercations stemmed from an off-campus incident that occurred over the weekend. After school dismissal, two additional students were involved in a separate and unrelated altercation. All incidents were addressed in accordance with our Code of Student Conduct and Discipline. As a precautionary measure, additional RCSS police officers will remain on campus for the remainder of the week.

We are committed to maintaining a safe and secure learning environment where all students can learn and grow. Gang-related activities, threats, or violence of any kind are unacceptable and will not be tolerated on our campuses. We will continue working closely with RCSS Police and the Richmond County Sheriff's Office to address and prevent this behavior.

We urge families to speak with their children about the serious consequences of their actions and to actively monitor their social media activity. We encourage our community to "see something, say something" by reporting any safety concerns to our front office or Safety Tip Line at (706) 828-1077, where reports may be made confidentially. School counselors and support staff are also available to assist any student who may need guidance or emotional support.
