
The laws prohibiting BID TAMPERING , controlled by 838.022, of the Florida State Statutes.

Clewiston City Hall is a large concrete building with several windows. The main entrance is on the southside of the building. This is City of Clewiston's City Hall 115 West Ventura Avenue Clewiston FL 33440

Security and all State Law Enforcement Officers, with the proper and necessary assistance, are hereby commanded to seize and search the above described location, seize and search the above listed electronic devices, and the city's remote servers, in the daytime or nighttime or Sunday, as the exigencies of the occasion may demand or require. This court orders the affidavit, search warrant, and inventory return for search warrant to be kept in the custody of the executing agency until further order of the court or until release by the executing agency, in order to maintain the integrity of the on-going investigation, pursuant to Florida Pub. Co. v. State, 706 So.2d 54 (Fla. 1st DCA 1988).
