Florida Residency Requirements for Recipients of First Dose of COVID-19 Vaccine

 Valid Florida Driver License or Florida Identification Card
OR
_ Two of the following items:
A deed, mortgage, monthly mortgage statement, mortgage payment booklet or residential rental or lease agreement. (Copies of deeds can be found on the Lee County Property Appraiser website https://leepa.org/)
A utility hookup or work order that is not more than 2 months old.
A utility bill that is not more than 2 months old.
Mail from a bank or other financial institution, including checking, savings, or investment account statements, that is not more than 2 months old.
Mail from a government agency that is not more than 2 months old. (Mail from a government agency can include tax bills showing a Florida address. Tax bills can be found on the Lee County Property Appraiser website https://leepa.org/)
One of the above items from the individual's parent, step-parent, legal guardian or other person with whom the individual resides <u>and</u> a statement from the parent, step-parent, legal guardian or other person with whom the person resides stating that the person does resides with him or her.

Please note, the above residency requirements do <u>NOT</u> apply to health care providers or individuals presenting for their second dose of the COVID-19 vaccine.
