Please Note: All bulbs must be counted by size and type prior to your arrival. Other Important Details:

- Businesses who want to be billed must have a \$25 minimum charge.
- Make your checks payable to: **The Retrofit Companies.**
- **DO NOT TAPE BULBS TOGETHER!** Rubber bands work well.
- If lights are broken, place pieces in a sealed, labeled container.
- Please store bulbs in the original packaging whenever possible.



We will accept up to ten (10) bulbs from businesses

Bulbs in excess of ten will be charged at the following rates:

4 ft. and under:	30c each	U-shaped and circular	50c each
5 ft. and over:	50c each	Compact Fluorescents:	40c each
HID Bulbs:	\$2.50 each	PCB Ballasts:	95c per pound
