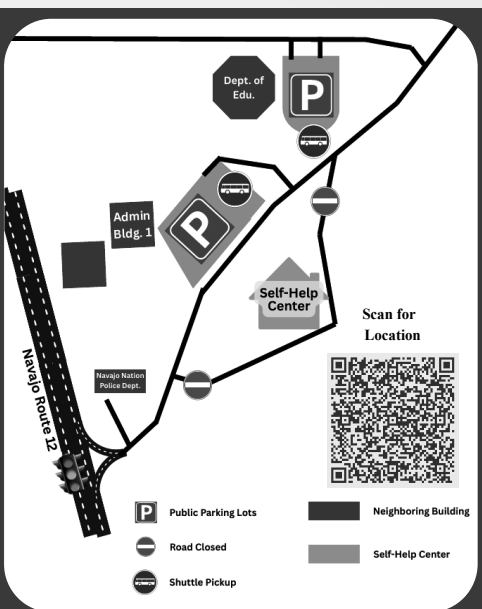


Come Celebrate the Grand Opening!
