Dear Mr. Coronado:

Re: Florencio Lozoya

Our firm is contacting you regarding the Town's concerns about Florencio Lozoya's response to a public records request involving documents related to the Town of Springerville.

Public records are defined by their content and purpose, not by the device on which they are stored. Records created, sent, received, or maintained by a public official related to official Town business are public records, regardless of whether they are stored on personal devices.

It has come to our attention that your client has numerous text messages on his personal phone related to Town of Springerville business, including, but not limited to, messages with former Town Manager Tim Rasmussen. These communications are directly related to the public records request made by a White Mountain Independent reporter in November 2025, which asked for records in your client's possession.

Despite this clear request, your client denied having such records on his mobile device and only provided texts from his Town-issued tablet. Attached is an email in which your client states, "My phone has no access to the town mail or quasi-official business." This claim is false, as the Town has in its possession text messages from his personal phone that contain information qualifying as public records under Arizona law.

Therefore, we formally demand that your client:

1. Produce all public records from Springerville stored on his personal phone and any other personal devices, including, but not limited to, all communications with the former Town Manager related to Town business; and
2. Provide a written explanation for the previous denial of these records and the failure to produce them in response to the public records request.

Please submit the requested records and explanation by February 6, 2026. Failure to comply may result in legal action to enforce public records laws and recover the messages belonging to the Town.

Additionally, the Town will notify the Arizona Attorney General's Office, which may impose personal civil penalties if it finds that his conduct was arbitrary, capricious, or done in bad faith. Moreover, if it is determined that he deleted, concealed, or used his personal phone to avoid disclosure after a records request, or misrepresented the existence of records, his conduct could be considered criminal, constituting official misconduct and tampering with public records.
