

VOTER REGISTRATION DEADLINE APRIL 21, 2026

You must register to vote by that date to be eligible to vote in the May 12th Primary Election. Any changes to your current voter registration must also be made by that date.



Which Ballot Am I Eligible to Vote in the 2026 Primary Election?

Republican	→	Republican
Democratic	→	Democratic
Mountain	→	Mountain (if available) or Non-Partisan
Libertarian	→	Non-Partisan
Constitution	→	Non-Partisan
No Party or Any Party Not Listed Above	→	Non-Partisan, Democratic, or Mountain (if available)

Effective December 1, 2024, pursuant to W. Va. Code § 3-2-31, the Republican Party only allows registered Republicans to vote the Republican Party ballot.

NEW WEST VIRGINIA VOTER IDENTIFICATION LAW §3-1-34.

Please be prepared to show one of the below accepted voter IDs at your polling location.

- West Virginia driver's license or state-issued ID
- Driver's license from another state
- U. S. passport or passport card
- Employee ID with photo issued by local, state, or federal government
- Student ID with photo from a WV institution of higher education or a WV high school
- U. S. military ID with photo
- Voter registration card with photo issued by a WV county clerk or the WV Secretary of State
- An ID issued by the DMV without a photo for voters who swear and affirm that they belong to recognized religious communities that prohibit them from being photographed

Of the IDs listed above, if the voter is 65 years of age or older and the ID is expired, it is still acceptable if the document was not expired on their 65th birthday.

If you have not already shown ID to confirm your legal residence address, and if the ID used above does not contain your legal residence address, you will be required to show one of the following proofs of residency in addition to your photo ID.

Current and Valid Photo ID – Current Utility Bill – Government Check
- Paycheck – Bank Statement – Official Government Document
