

CHAPTER 6, SECTION 2 CONSTRUCTION/MODIFICATION PERMIT - Department of Environmental Quality, Division of Air Quality PUBLIC NOTICE: In accordance with Chapter 6, Section 2(m) of the Wyoming Air Quality Standards and Regulations, notice is hereby given that the State of Wyoming, Department of Environmental Quality, Division of Air Quality, proposes to approve a request by Crowheart Energy, LLC (CMP100542) to modify and operate the Flat Top 14 PAD (F032085) with the addition of production and equipment associated with two new wells, the Flat Top 14-15-2LH and 14-25-3LH, with two vapor recovery units and one smokeless combustion device to control volatile organic compound and hazardous air pollutant emissions associated with the condensate tanks, active produced water tanks, vapor recovery tower, heater treater and truck loading, located in the NE1/4 NE1/4 of Section 14, T15N, R93W, approximately nineteen (19) miles north-northwest of Baggs, in Carbon County, Wyoming.
