

# **INVITATION FOR BIDS**

The Town of Burns, WY (hereinafter "Town") will receive sealed bids at Town Hall, 327 South Main Street, Burns, WY 82053 (PO Box 66), until 11:00 a.m. Local Time on January 29, 2026, for the Burns Fox Hills Monitoring Well Project. At the aforementioned time and place, such bids that are received for the project shall be opened and reviewed.

A non-mandatory pre-bid Conference will be held on January 21, 2026, starting at 10:30 AM local time, at the Town of Burns Town Hall.

The work to be performed under this project shall consist of furnishing all labor, materials, and equipment required to construct the Burns Fox Hills Monitoring Well called for by the contract documents and construction plans. The work shall include drilling and constructing a 5" diameter steel cased well (or at Contractor option, a 6" diameter steel cased well) with 4-1/2" well screen, completed in the Fox Hills Formation, expected to be at a depth of 1000 to 1225'. Work to be performed includes: drilling a pilot hole, assisting the Engineer/Geologist with collecting cuttings; geo-physical logging of the pilot hole; reaming the pilot hole for installation of the casing and screen; furnishing and installing casing and screen, gravel pack and grouting/sealing material; development work on the well; furnishing, installing, and removing a test pump; and conducting the test pumping; furnishing and installing a lockable seal on the monitoring well; and site clean-up. All work shall be done by a Wyoming licensed well-driller and Wyoming licensed pump installer.

The final completion date of this project is June 3, 2026.

The work to be performed will be in accordance with the plans and specifications prepared by Dahlgren Consulting, Inc. To obtain plans, interested parties shall send an email to: [dahlgrenconsult@aol.com](mailto:dahlgrenconsult@aol.com). A pdf version of the project manual can be obtained, or a printed project manual will be mailed at a cost of \$25.00.

A bid guarantee in the amount of five percent (5%) of the total bid shall accompany any bid submitted. A cashier's check and/or a bid bond will be accepted as the bid guarantee. The successful bidder shall furnish and pay for satisfactory performance and payment bonds in the amount of one hundred percent (100%) of the accepted bid.

The Town of Burns reserves the right to reject any or all bids or to waive any formalities in the bidding. Prior to award of the contract, the Town of Burns may hold bids for a period not to exceed twenty-one (21) calendar days from the date of opening of bids for the purpose of reviewing the bids and investigating the qualifications of the bidders.
