

PUBLIC NOTICE

Pursuant to the Wyoming Administrative Procedure Act and the Wyoming Public Service Commission's (Commission) Rules and Regulations, notice is hereby given of the Application of Questar Gas Company d/b/a Enbridge Gas Wyoming (Enbridge or the Company) for authority to update the Wyoming Natural Gas Tariff No. 5 (Tariff No. 5) carrying charge, as more fully described below.

1. Enbridge is a division of Enbridge, Inc., a Canadian corporation, engaged in the business of supplying energy services in several states, including natural gas distribution service in Wyoming. Enbridge is a public utility subject to the Commission's jurisdiction. Wyo. Stat. §§ 37-1-101(a)(vi)(D) and 37-2-112.

2. On April 14, 2026, Enbridge filed its Application, pursuant to Commission Rule Chapter 3, Section 21, requesting authority to update the two-way carrying charge, in Tariff No. 5, applied to Balancing Account 191.5 associated with the Voluntary Carbon Offset Program from 5.40% to 5.68%. The voluntary program provides a customer the option to purchase blocks of carbon offsets defined as 0.3522 metric tons of carbon-dioxide equivalent.

3. The Company uses the Utah carrying charges for the Wyoming program and updates them annually adjusted for the corresponding tax deferral balance in Account 283. The Utah Public Service Commission approved the 5.68% carrying charge for this program April 2026. Enbridge requests an effective date for the Wyoming tariff of May 1, 2026, if approved by the Commission.

4. This is not a complete description of the Application. Any interested person may inspect the Application at the Commission's office in Cheyenne, Wyoming or at the Company's business office in Rock Springs, Wyoming, or at <https://dms.wyo.gov/external/publicusers.aspx> (enter Record No. 18113).

5. Anyone desiring to file a statement, intervention petition, protest or request for a hearing, in this matter must file with the Commission in writing on or before May 22, 2026. A proposed intervention or request for hearing must set forth the grounds, the position and interest of the petitioner. Please mention **Docket No. 30010-244-GT-26** in your communications.
