

REQUEST FOR APPLICATIONS FOR FFY 2027 COMMUNITY SERVICES BLOCK GRANT (CSBG) PROGRAM

The CSBG Board of Directors of Albany County is accepting applications from nonprofit service providers for funding for Federal Fiscal Year (FFY) 2027 (October 1, 2026-September 30, 2027). Albany County's allocation is expected to be approximately \$190,000.

Funding is intended for programs that provide services to meet the needs of low-income persons and promote self-sufficiency. Priorities include health (including behavioral health) care; substance use services; affordable housing; and coordinating, publicizing, and expanding services.

CSBG funds must be used to serve clients who are at or below 200% of the federal poverty level (that percentage depends on Congressional action and could drop to 125% during the FFY). The State of Wyoming (Department of Health, Community Services Program) requires CSBG service providers to verify and document the income of each person receiving CSBG-funded services, enter data into a specified database system (empowOR), and provide detailed reports. The State of Wyoming provides monthly funding to Albany County on a reimbursement basis -- service providers must be in a position to cover the costs of services and then request reimbursement.

Completed applications from Albany County service providers are due to the Albany County Grants Office, Attn: Bailey Quick by 5:00 p.m. July 15, 2026. Submit applications electronically to grants@albanycountywy.gov. The CSBG Board will be reviewing applications and finalize funding recommendations at the August 3, 2026 meeting at 4:30pm at the High Point CPA conference room (401 Fremont St., Laramie, WY 82072).
