QUALIFYING FOR THE 2027 NATIONAL SENIOR GAMES

1. All first-, second-, third- and fourth-place winners, or athletes meeting NSGA minimum performance standards at a 2026 NSGA qualifying games, qualify for the 2027 National Senior Games.
2. Athletes who reside in a state that does not offer Pole Vault may qualify for that event by meeting the "limited" event qualifying criteria in Rule D.
3. Athletes who qualify for and compete in the 50M, 100M, 200M, 400M, or 800M at the 2027 National Senior Games are eligible to compete in the 4x100M Relay. Athletes may not qualify for the relay in any other manner.
