



Trend coverage and community sourcing policy

Oftentimes crime and public safety coverage can be focused on individual novelty cases, rather than the ongoing trends that communities face. The Wyoming Tribune Eagle aims to limit its coverage of novelty cases in order to focus more on the ongoing issues that impact the daily lives of community members. That means not always covering a basic theft case in order to cover trends around theft in the area, for example.
