INFORMATION

COMES NOW, Jeffrey O'Holleran, Assistant District Attorney, of the County of Laramie and State of Wyoming, First Judicial District, and in the name and by the authority of the State of Wyoming, informs the Court and gives the Court to understand that **ANDREW JONATHAN WEAVER** late of county aforesaid, did unlawfully:

Count I: Theft < \$1000

1. On or about September 08, 2019;
2. In the County of Laramie and the State of Wyoming;
3. **ANDREW JONATHAN WEAVER**;
4. did knowingly take or exercise unauthorized control over or make an unauthorized transfer of an interest in the property of another person with the purpose of depriving the other person of the property, and the value of the property is less than one thousand dollars (\$1,000.00), to wit: **ANDREW JONATHAN WEAVER** did knowingly take or exercise unauthorized control over or make an unauthorized transfer of an interest in a black Century Arms 9mm handgun, Model TP9SA, the property of William Pharoah with intent to deprive William Pharoah the owner or lawful possessor, and the value of the property is Two hundred ninety dollars (\$290.00), in

Penalties: 0 - 6 months and/or \$750 Fine


Count II: Possession of Methamphetamine - Misdemeanor

1. On or about September 08, 2019;
2. In the County of Laramie and the State of Wyoming;
3. **ANDREW JONATHAN WEAVER;**
4. did knowingly or intentionally possess under three (3) grams of a Schedule II non-narcotic controlled substance in powder or crystalline form, to wit: **ANDREW JONATHAN WEAVER** did knowingly or intentionally possess methamphetamine, as defined by the Wyoming Controlled Substance Act of 1971, WYO. STAT. §35-7-1016(d)(ii), in violation of WYO. STAT. §35-7-1031(c)(i)(C), 2019 Lexis, the same being a Misdemeanor, contrary to the form of the statute in such case made and provided, and against the peace and dignity of the State of Wyoming. (SEE AFFIDAVIT OF PROBABLE CAUSE);

Penalties: 0 - 12 months, and/or \$0 - \$1,000 Fine



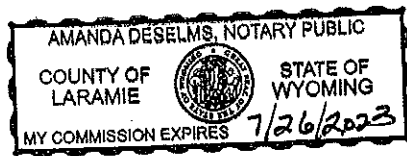

4. William said just before he went to sleep the gun was in the living room and Andrew was still at the house. This morning when he woke up, he noticed the gun and Andrew were both missing. Ashley Meyer told me she was with Andrew until about 0100 hours this morning when Andrew left the residence on foot. She said he had to walk because he doesn't have a working vehicle. Ashley said she last knew Andrew to be living with a female named Stormie Bacon at 3515 Boston Rd in Cheyenne, Wy.
5. I went to 3515 Boston Rd and met with Stormie Bacon. She told me she kicked Andrew out of her home a couple of weeks ago due to his drug use and erratic behavior, however his car is still at the location broke down and occasionally he shows up to talk with Stormie's husband. A neighbor across the street from 3515 Boston Rd said they saw Andrew at the home around 0630 hours this morning, he was banging around outside but never went into the home. The neighbor said Andrew was driving an old tan four door car. Stormie told me the last she knew of Andrew's whereabouts was in what Andrew referred to as "Tweaker Village". She said this was a trailer park off of East Fox Farm Rd near the health center. The trailer park in this area would be 2205 Gordon Rd or 2314 Persons Rd, both back up to one another. She mentioned he may be staying with Tracy Cummings AKA "Tracy Buys" or Amber Bundy. I mentioned these two names to Deputy Adam Wright and he knew both of them to be living at 2205 Gordon Rd #16.
6. Deputy Wright and I drove to 2205 Gordon Rd #16. I knocked on the door and a young male voice asked "Who is it?" Then an elderly man, Charles Gutherie, answered the door. I initially asked if Andrew was there and Charles told me "no". I asked if Tracy was home so I could inquire about Andrew's whereabouts. Charles told me Tracy was asleep, I asked him to wake her. Charles returned and said Tracy was coming and that he was mistaken earlier that Andrew was in the house. I asked Charles to ask him to step out also.
7. Andrew came out to talk to me. I removed a can of pepper spray container from his waistband. Andrew also told me he had a knife in his pocket and he started to grab it. I

told him not to reach for it and as I went to take it he told me he had needles in his pocket also, I removed three syringes and a large black tactical style knife from his pocket.


8. I asked Andrew if he had recently purchased a firearm from William. I thought maybe there may be a communication error between the two men. Andrew told me he is not allowed to own or possess firearms due to his past felony convictions. I asked Andrew if he was at 3400 South Greeley Highway #33 and he said he had been there for a couple of days, he said Ashley is his ex-girlfriend. He said he left the home about 0100 hours this morning and was picked up by Tracy and Amber somewhere on South Greeley Highway in the car that was in the driveway, a tan four door car, and they brought him to 2205 Gordon Rd. #16. Andrew told me he does not live anywhere and is homeless.
9. I explained William reported a missing firearm. I asked Andrew if I looked through the car that he rode in if I would find the gun that William said was missing. Andrew told me no. I asked Andrew if I looked in the home if I would find the gun, he seemed unsure how to answer.
10. Deputy Wright spoke to Charles Guthrie, the home owner, and asked if he could look through the home and Charles consented. Meanwhile Andrew began screaming into Charles not to allow us to search, Charles consented anyway. Deputy Wright walked through the home and found the missing gun in the bathroom laying on top of the counter. Additionally, another female, Amber Bundy, exited a bedroom. She was hiding because she thought she had a warrant, she did not.
11. I spoke to Tracy and Amber and asked them how Andrew got to 2205 Gordon Rd #16. They told me they picked up Andrew, in the tan car outside, on South Greeley Highway near the Maverick gas station. Amber told me Andrew was wearing the pistol on his hip in the holster. She said Andrew was also wearing a blue back pack. I asked if the gun box was in the backpack and she said she did not know. Charles interrupted and said yes. Charles said he watched Andrew take the gun box from his backpack this

morning.

12. Since a stolen gun was found I placed Andrew into handcuffs under investigative detention. Deputy Wright read Andrew Miranda and Andrew agreed to speak with us. Deputy Wright asked Andrew if he had any other needles in his pockets and Andrew told us he had some meth in his wallet. We removed the wallet and found a small amount of methamphetamines in his pocket. Andrew told us he was currently under the influence of methamphetamines and was suicidal.
13. A NCIC check revealed Andrew has convictions for robbery with a weapon, burglary and kidnapping amongst other felony charges the criminal history was not clear as to whether Andrew was disqualified from being in possession of a firearm.
