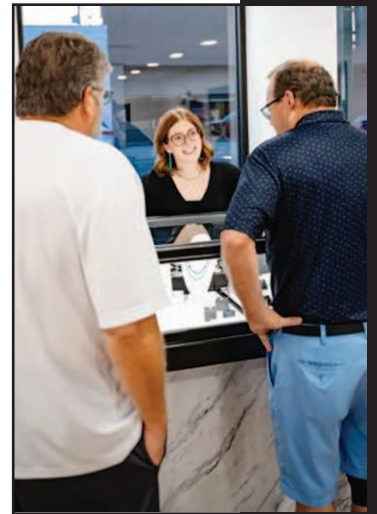
monds, making the store a true destination for Nebraska shoppers.
