Holthus To Take- Cashier Post At First National

Marion C. Bonham, president of the First National Bank of York, has announced that C. G. "Kelly" Holthus has been appointed cashier at the First National and will assume his duties effective Monday, November 8.

Holthus Named President Of First National Bank

C. G. (Kelly) Holthus, 43-year-old executive vice president and cashier of First National Bank of York, has been named president of the bank effective Jan. 1. Holthus, who has been associated with the bank for 11 years, replaces Marion Bonham, who resigned earlier this year.

Announcement of the new president was made by Robert V. Jones, chairman of the board of directors, following a Tuesday meeting.

A 24-year veteran of the banking business, Holthus is a native of Bertrand. He started with the First National Bank of York in 1965 as a cashier and was promoted to vice president and cashier the following year. In 1971 he was elected to the board of directors and was named executive vice president and cashier in 1976.

Holthus came to York from Kimball where he was vice president and cashier at the American National Bank. Prior to that he was associated with the Bank of Bertrand for 11½ years.

A 1950 graduate of Bertrand High School, Holthus attended the University of Nebraska and is a 1970 graduate of the University of Wisconsin Graduate School of Banking.

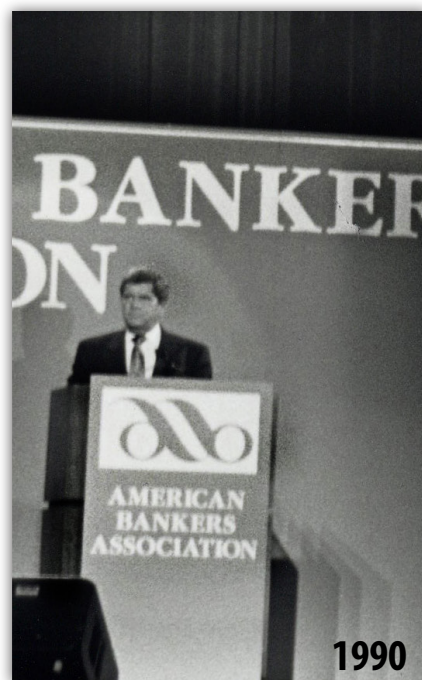
